For example, I looked up to my parents. Both my mom and dad worked hard to support and provide for myself and my brothers. They set an example of what kind of person I want to be. Other people I looked up to are my mentors, Club staff, and my friends. Each and every one of them have opened my eyes and taught me how to help others and create connections with them. Now that I am a teenager, this inspired me to help in many ways because of what the Club did for me when I was younger.

Being part of the Boys & Girls Club has taught me many skills and traits that will help me in the future. Taking on leadership roles at the Club like volunteering with the younger kids, coaching the 6/7 year old soccer team, helping with homework, or even mentoring a few of the members allowed me to learn what it takes to be a leader. I also learned discipline and patience by knowing how to efficiently complete tasks. The Club taught me that everything has a process with a start and finish, so I take those skills and use them in my everyday life. This is what sparked an interest in engineering and opened my eyes to a new career path.

Finding my Club was the light at the end of my tunnel, and the Club became my very own pillar of strength. In the fall of 2021 I started at NC State, and my journey is only starting. There's going to be lots of bumps down the road, however, by helping people and enduring these bumps, my journey will be an interesting one. Thank you!

Our 19th Annual Breakfast of Champions was held on November 1st and was our second virtual Breakfast of Champions event due to the ongoing pandemic. Led by event Co-Chairs Grant Fisher and Gordon Brown, the Breakfast of Champions raised record funds! We heard about the power of being given a chance from UNC Head Men's Basketball Coach Hubert Davis and were delighted to induct Ham Sloan into the Boys & Girls Clubs Hall of Fame.



Of special note this year, particularly because of the disruption caused by the pandemic, we are proud to have our staff trained in Youth Mental Health First Aid. 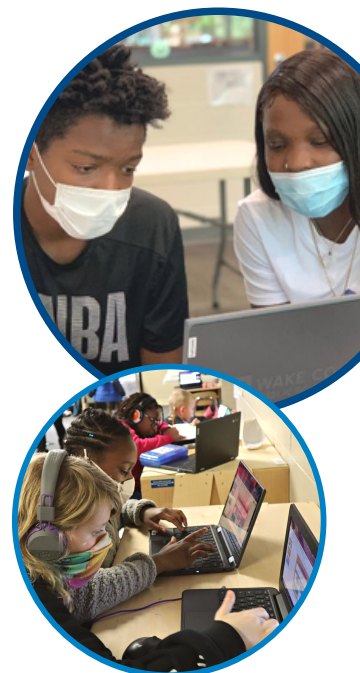


COVID-19 Response and Recovery

Whatever It Takes to Help Kids Learn

From August 2020 to June 2021, our Clubs transformed from an after-school program to an all-day virtual learning site. Members completed their remote learning at the Club, receiving support from Club staff and volunteers. Here are some of the ways we transitioned our programs to help our kids succeed:

- Participated in the Families and Schools Together (FAST) Initiative with other community agencies to support Wake County students in remote learning in a safe and productive environment.
- Partnered with Passage Home's REACH program to transport students experiencing homelessness from six hotels in the area to the nearest Boys & Girls Club so they could attend school remotely.
- Partnered with the Project for Equitable Access in Remote Learning (PEARL) to support members at our Teen Center with academic support from college and graduate students.
- Ensured members had devices, travelled to schools to pick up school supplies, helped kids log in to their classes, managed multiple class schedules, and assisted members with their assignments.
- Provided lunch and a snack each day, as well as fun programs at the end of the school day targeted at leadership development, life skills, health and nutrition, social/emotional wellbeing, sports, and other fun activities.
- Continued to support members in remote learning until the end of the school year.

Summer was filled with Camp BTI, STEM learning, arts and crafts, sports, carnivals, and tons of exciting games and activities.
